NAEMT's Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) is recognized around the world as the leading continuing education program for prehospital emergency trauma care. The mission of PHTLS is to promote excellence in trauma patient management by all providers involved in the delivery of prehospital care. This in-classroom course allows the student to obtain PHTLS certification upon successful completion of the course. This course results in16 hours of continuing education for the Paramedic or EMT (CAPCE). PHTLS is developed by NAEMT in cooperation with the American College of Surgeons' Committee on Trauma. The Committee provides the medical direction and content oversight for the PHTLS program. ## **Course Dates:**

January 23<sup>rd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>, 2023 8:00AM – 5:00PM

Attendance at all classes is required, 1 or more absences will likely result in course failure.

Course Location: All classes will be held at the Northfield Hospital EMS Station, 1600 Riverview Ln, Northfield, MN, 55057.

Cost: The cost is \$250 (discounts available for affiliated agencies and hospital employees and their family members). All fees must be paid in full by the first night of class – January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. Cost includes tuition, borrowed textbook, handouts, electronic testing program fees and certification fees. Agencies can be invoiced. Tuition Fee includes borrowed printed textbook. *Textbooks can be purchased to keep for \$70.00*. Textbook selection is made during registration.

**Registration is required.** No walk-ins will be allowed. Course size is limited, and registrations are handled on a first-come, first-served basis. A waiting list will be established if needed.

- Individual review of the course textbook is required prior to the first day of class.
- A required course Pre-Test must be completed prior to the first day of class.
